Worship Challenge

Mrs Dorrington explained to the council that it was their job to come up with the Worship Challenges each half term, although they don't always need to be competitions. The group discussed what a Worship Challenge is, for the benefit of our EYFS member. Mrs Dorrington explained to the children about Odd Socks Day which is happening in two weeks' time. It was suggested that this half term's Worship Challenge could be linked to Odd Socks Day because it aims to promote love, respect and tolerance as part of anti-bullying week; all things that the council want to encourage in school. The council all thought this was a good idea and ideas for the challenge were discussed.
