1	To audit the learning environment for evidence of diversity and multiculturalism.	 Church School Council to complete a tick sheet audit in their classroom and to gather views from the children in their class. DG to audit library books. SM to continue to highlight key multicultural events and celebrations at the top of the KS1 corridor. 	Children's audit was positive. They feel represented within school. 2	To extend children's awareness of stories from other cultures.	 Collective Worship to include stories from other cultures, read by someone from that culture / ethnicity. Introduce this in the second half of the spring term, at least once a month. Gather feedback from pupils via the Church School Council. 	Stories from Portugal, Romania and South Africa featured this half term. Positive feedback from pupils.
3	To celebrate food and drink from a range of different cultures.	 DG to set an Easter holiday challenge, asking pupils to prepare a traditional dish from their culture, take a photo of it and list the ingredients / recipe. Share via ClassDojo. Create a display area in school to celebrate and raise awareness. 	Easter holiday challenge will be set in the last week of term. Darren will produce a display in the hall to showcase pupils' work.
