2	To extend children's awareness of stories from other cultures.	 Collective Worship will include stories from other cultures, read by someone from that culture / ethnicity. South Africa, Romania, Poland and India to be featured this term. Gather feedback from pupils via the Church School Council. 	America and France added to the schedule. Children have enjoyed these assemblies, especially when they have heard their own language spoken.
3	To organise an after school club / project with a focus on 'Story Harvesting'.	 Darren will liaise with David Matthews and submit a bid to IOA for funding. David will organise and run the sessions in school this term. Parents and grandparents of Year 5 & 6 pupils will be invited to share their stories of immigration. Pupils will produce a written version which will feature on story cards alongside professionally shot photographs of the families.
