We are learning 4 new letter sounds each week and we teach these using our Phonics scheme...

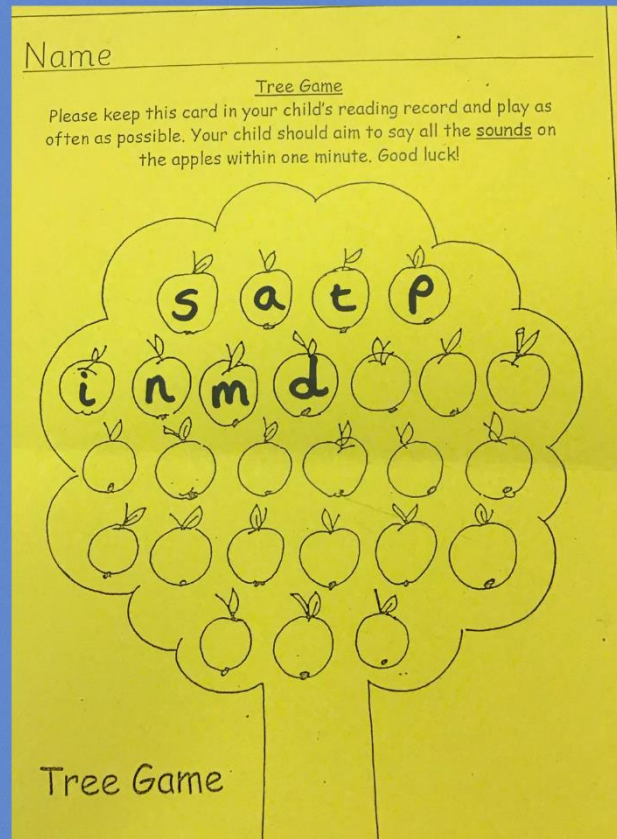

The children will use the sounds that they have learnt to read simple words (say-it-fast)

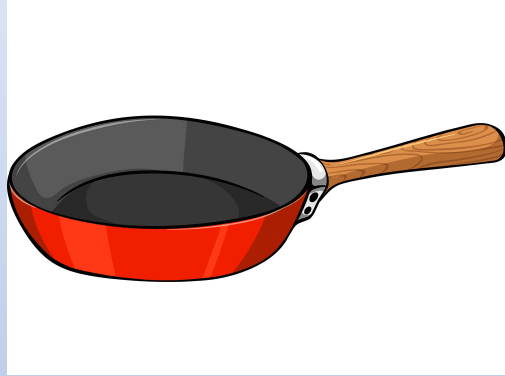

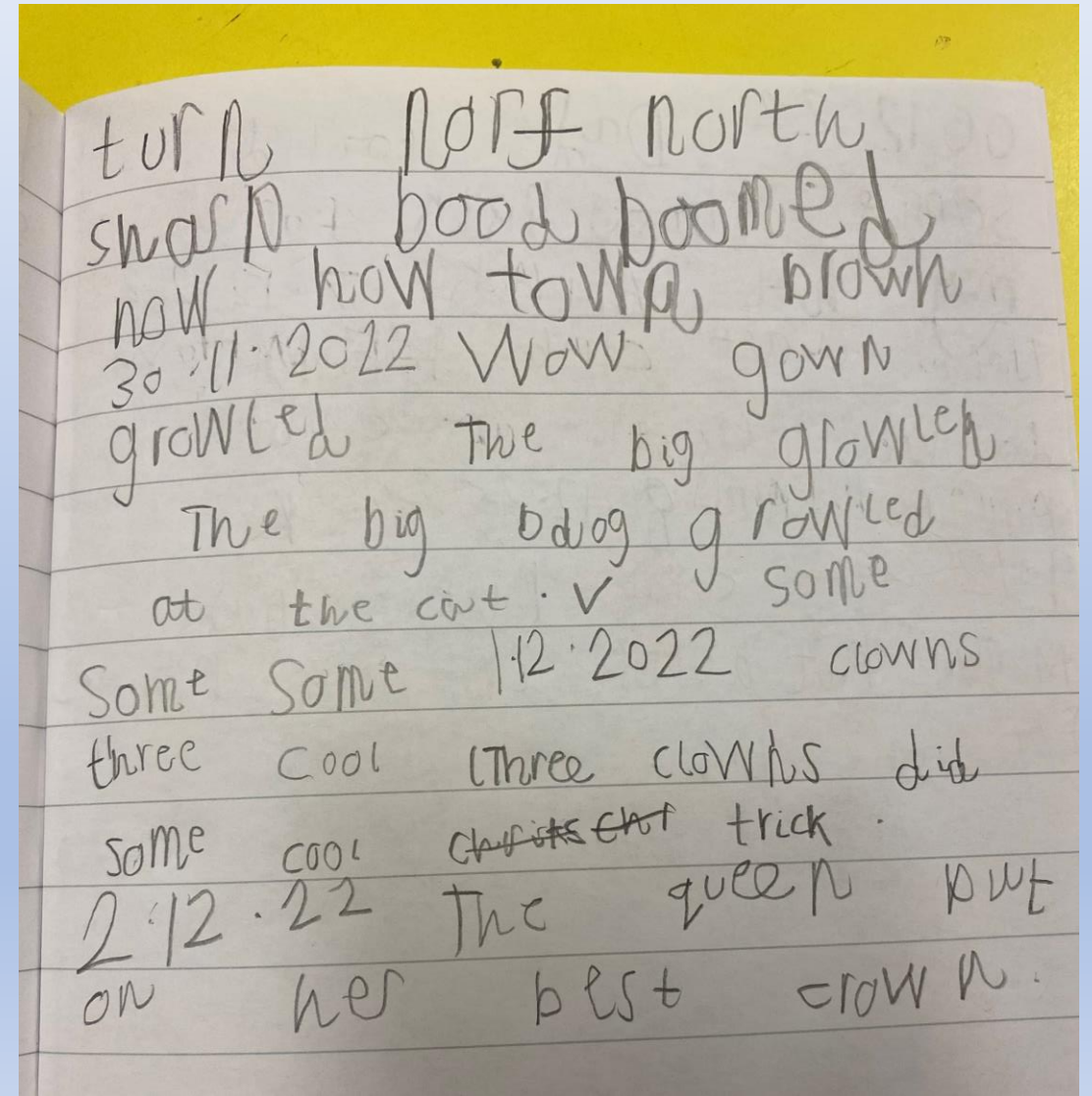
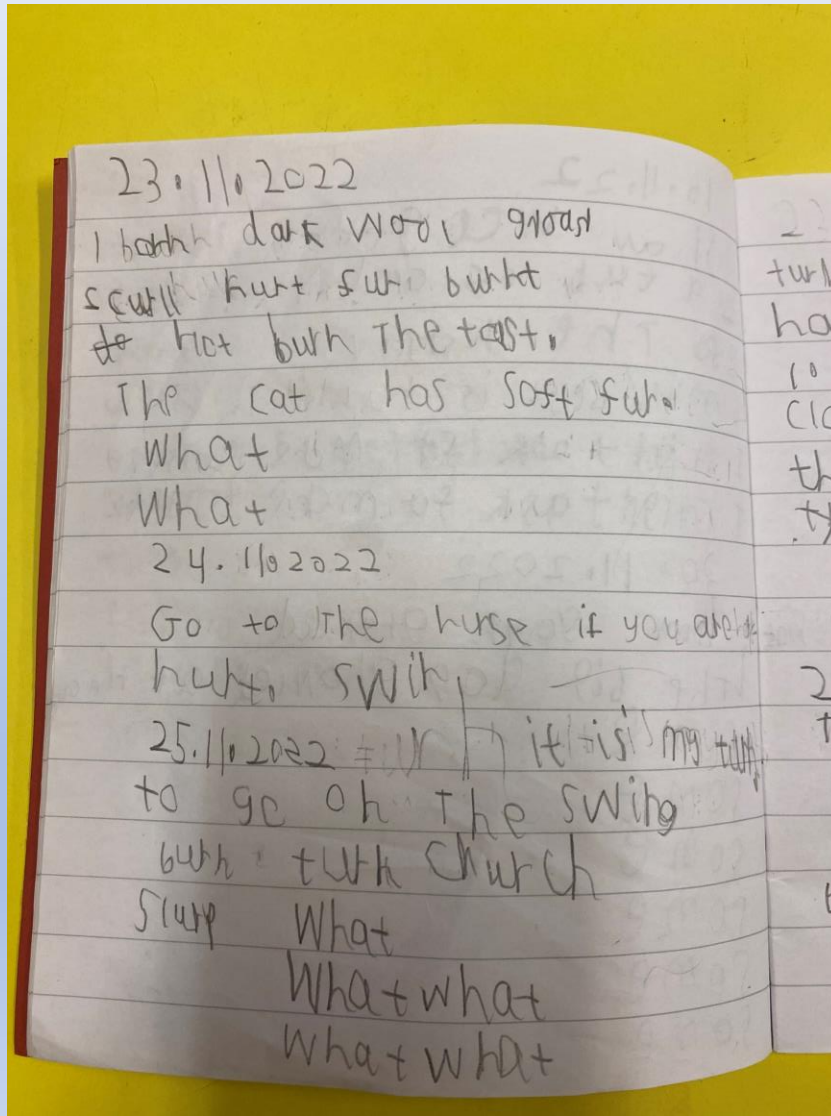

Shared reading

In addition to our phonics lessons, we will be reading books every day from our 'Shared Reader' scheme. We will share the same book for a week...



When we are reading with the children we are focussing on:

- *using their phonics knowledge to work out what the words are.**
- *comprehension - making sure they understand what they have read**
- *fluency - reading the book with speed, accuracy and expression**

These skills will only come with lots of practice and for that reason your child will keep the same reading book for several days.
