A Guide to our School Uniform

Pupils should choose their uniform from the items shown below. Clothing should be appropriate for the weather but there are no separate winter / summer guidelines. Uniform is not restricted by gender. For example, girls may wear trousers and boys may wear cardigans.

All year groups



St Matthew's navy school jumper or cardigan with pale blue stripes.

Dark grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress.



Navy cap or hat.

Navy, black or white plain hair accessories. No oversized bows.

Long hair must be tied back.

White or grey socks.

Grey tights.

Plain black shoes or boots.

No high heels.

Key Stage 2 Years 3 - 6



Pale blue shirt with a St Matthew's school tie.

PE kit Years 1 - 6
