SCHOOL RULES

The school rules are as follows:

- 1. We are kind and respectful.
- 2. We follow instructions.
- 3. We keep our hands and feet to ourselves.

We use a behaviour clipboard to encourage pupils to follow the rules. Below you will find the repercussion of a child's name being added to the clipboard:

- 1st Time: Fill in a white letter during playtime which is then sent home.
- 2nd Time: Pupil moves name to 'Yellow Zone' and receives a 'Yellow Letter' from Senior Leadership.
- 3rd Time: Pupil moves name to 'Red Zone' and speaks to the head teacher, who then sends a 'Red Letter' home.

Behaviour charts are reset at the end of each week.

If there is a serious incident, such as fighting or bad language, a child may move straight to yellow.
