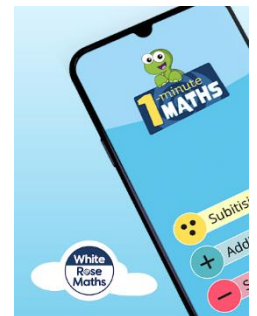


This half term, our topic is Ancient Civilisations and fables. Please see the curriculum information below for more detail:
