This newsletter contains all the information you need for the second half of Spring Term. Thank you once again for all you do to support your children's learning.

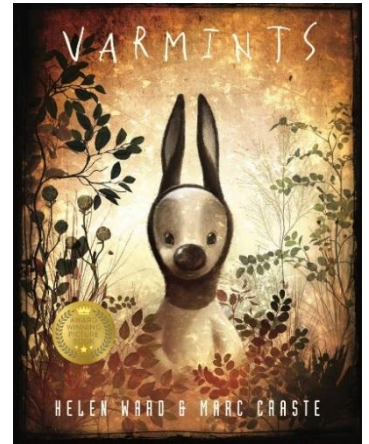
