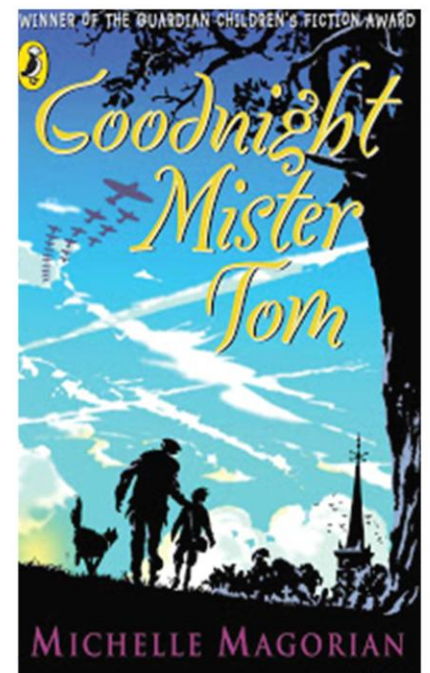

As part of our learning on the Second World War, we would like to hold a topic day.
