Speeding outside the school and road safety

Last year, some of the School Council Reps expressed their concern over the road safety outside our school. After the Clean Air Day last year and the visit from the Police to manage the arrival of the children, the issue of illegal parking on the yellow zigzag lines and speeding outside the school, was highlighted. The Reps are still concerned about it. Yr 4 Rep disclosed that he was nearly hit by a speeding car outside our school recently. The Reps thought of what could be done about the issue:

- traffic and road sign survey outside of school (next meeting)
- posters highlighting the importance of safe driving and dangers of speeding (Miss Zych to announce the poster competition on Dojo-deadline before our next meeting)
- speed bumps to calm the traffic
- 20 mph speed limit
- lollipop person (is it possible?)

We read some information from the Police.uk website and we know that we can raise our concern with the local councillor. Miss Zych found the details of the local Councillor responsible for Transport Strategy so we have his contact details when we are ready write our letter to him requesting the speed limit to be put in place. We will look at the 20 mph speed limit criteria checklist and conduct the traffic and road sing survey during our next meeting before our letter.
